QUESTIONS AND NOTES

- → What reactions both positive and negative, can we have to uncertainty? How does it impact our walk with the Lord?
- → 5:1-2 God provides His word to restart and support the work
 - What did God do to get the work started and supported again?
 - Flick through Haggai and remind yourselves what God spoke to the people
- → 5:3-17 God provides a way to make progress through uncertainty
 - What uncertainty do the people of God face in 5:3-17? What do they do and how?
 - How has God allowed you to make progress during the uncertainty of the coronavirus?
 - How might someone continue to make progress in their faith in these situations:
 - Severe sickness
 - Deep depression
 - High pressure work setting

- → 6:1-12 God provides abundant help
 - Read 6:1-12. How does God provide protection, sacrifice and support?
 - How do we receive protection, sacrifice and support now through Jesus?
 - What difference does each of these make when we face difficult or uncertain times?
- → Summarise and Apply
 - What in this passage leads us to worship Jesus?
 - What do we learn about ourselves from this passage? How does it lead us to give thanks or repent?
 - How might this help us share the good news with our friends and neighbours who don't know Jesus?
