REFLECTION

QUESTIONS AND NOTES

First read

- Look through the Psalm.

- Where in the Psalm do we see God's glory and power
- What response should we have to that?
- How can we keep our eyes open to God's revealed glory in the world?

God's care for the small

- God is mindful and cares for us
- How does that affect how we think of God, ourselves and others?

God uses the small

- God sets us to rule over all he has made
- What might it mean for each of you to think of stewarding God's creation?
- How does having that mindset change how we live?

God becomes man

- Read Hebrews 2:6-11
- How does this shape how we read Psalm 8?

Summarise and Apply

- What in this passage leads us to worship Jesus?
- What do we learn about ourselves from this passage? How does it lead us to give thanks or repent?
- How might this help us share the good news with our friends and neighbours who don't know Jesus?
