- Why might Peter have been afraid of the circumcision group?
 - Think of a time when you have not done the right thing because of fear or where you might be tempted not to do the right thing because of fear.
- Read Acts 10-11. What do we learn about Gentiles and eating with them?
- Paul confronts the issue with a statement about justification by faith.
 - Why does he do that?
- According to the passage, how do we go on living life as a christian?
 What does that mean for how we live our lives this week?
- Read Acts 15 which may give a summary of how Peter responded.
